General Information:

Game Day

North Harbour Rugby home games held at QBE Stadium, on Stadium Drive, Albany, Auckland

Gates generally open an hour before kick-off, so for a game at 7.35pm; the gates will open at 6.30pm. However it does vary on the dependence of a curtain raiser game which will normally entail the gates to open earlier.

Entry to games is via gate A or H; wheelchair access is available through both gats A and H.

Parking

There is limited parking at the stadium, however it is available in Carpark H at a cost of \$5.00 per

vehicle however, parking is available in Hootons Reserve free.

Public Transport: The Northern Express bus service operates from Britomart to Albany Station. From Albany Station, it is a 10-15minute walk to QBE Stadium; use the Journey Planner to plan your journey to QBE Stadium.

Merchandise

The Merchandise outlet is located in the concourse area of the main lower grandstand and accepts either cash or EFTPOS payments.

ATM/ cash out facilities

There is no ATM onsite.

First Aid

During games there are First Aid stations located at various points around the stadium, as well as St Johns staff located on site.

Food & Beverage

Food and Beverage is offered throughout the stadium within close proximity to patron seating, all outlets accept cash and EFTPOS; however cash is often more efficient. You are welcome to bring in small amounts of non-commercially prepared food such as sandwiches, baking, and fruit. You may also bring a sealed bottle of water (up to 1 litre) however please be advised that the lid will be removed and discarded on arrival.

Following are the only accepted forms of ID for the purchase and consumption of alcohol:

- A valid passport
- New Zealand Drivers Licence
- HANZ 18+ Card

Alcoholic Bevearges must not be taken in or out of QBE Stadium. You may not supply alcohol to anyone under 18 on QBE Stadium premises. Anyone intoxicated patrons will be removed from the premises and will not be re-admitted.

Conditions of Entry

Customer Safety

- Appropriate shoes and attire must be worn.

Behaviour & Etiquette

Prohibited

- Alcohol in any type of container.
- Bottles of any kind.
- Gang patches or colours.
- Firearms, fireworks, flares, laser lights.
- Weapons of any kind.
- Illegal substances.
- Spray paint, tagging equipment.
- Animals other than guide dogs.
- Commercially branded food and drink (e.g. fast food).
- Signs or banners that are obscene, offensive or abusive.
- Any other item that management determine may cause injury or public nuisance or inconvenience to any other person.
